Prayer for the World - Zena Greig continued Yemen

The conflict in Yemen is causing the largest humanitarian crisis in the world with 80% of the population in need of aid and protection.

There is widespread collapse of it's healthcare, water, water and sanitation systems posing a dangerous set of circumstances for the arrival of Covid-19 and cholera. Please pray for aid agencies especially Tear Fund as their resources are stretched as never before.

Open Doors - Betsy Kolkea

Persecution of Christians is continuing to rise globally, with 340 million experiencing high levels of persecution and discrimination.

Let's pray for North Korea where those discovered to be Christians are either executed or imprisoned and suffer continual torture, hunger and labour with no chance of release. Open Doors are supporting 90,000 North Korean believers with vital food and aid.

Let's pray for Nigerian Christians, more of whom are murdered for their faith than in any other country. Violence is increasing, as Islamic extremist groups attack Christians, murdering, abducting, raping and destroying property and livelihoods.

Let's pray for the few thousand known Christians in Yemen. It is forbidden to leave Islam, and those converting to Christianity face death. Christians are particularly suffering during the civil war and pandemic as any aid is distributed through Muslim leaders.

What if we had to meet in secret? What if we faced imprisonment, rape, torture, separation from our families, for being Christians? What if we were treated as second class citizens, discriminated against in education, employment, and economic opportunity for being Christians? Let us stand with our Christian brothers and sisters around the world for whom this is their reality today. Persecution of Christians is continuing to rise globally,
