Narges Nasri is 37, pregnant with her first child, and facing 16 years imprisonment.

In Hebrews 13 we are exhorted to 'Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering'. Let's all stand with Narges, Abbas and Mehran, imagining it was ourselves who were facing imprisonment for going to our connect group and church.
